Half Day Sightseeing Tour in Budapest



Passing by the Parliament we cross the Danube on the Margaret Bridge (Margaret Island) we drive to the Castle District on the Buda side, where we visit the Fishermen's Bastion (promenade) the Matthias church (interior visit) and the old town. Driving towards the Gellert hill rising over the Danube we can obtain the widest panorama of the capital from the Viewpoint Terrace. We cross Elisabeth Bridge and through the Downtown of Pest we visit the Old City Market Hall. Along the Little Boulevard and the Andrassy Boulevard we pass will the Opera. In the City Park we will be stopping and visit the Vajdahunyad Castle and the Heroes square. Passing the elegant Stefania Boulevard and Zuglo, the district of embassies we reach the People's Stadium and its establishments. Along the Rakoczi Street we arrive to the inner city of Pest, where the sight-seeing ends.

Half Day Szentendre Nostalgia



Approx. 20 km (12 min.) from Budapest situated Szentendre, small Baroque town of Hungarian artists. The town got its unique character from its orthodox colonies in the 15th century. Szentendre has been a home of many famous Hungarian artists at the turn of the century. After a promenade through the seven churches' old town we visit the country's most popular museums, the Margit Kovacs ceramic collection. You have time to walk a little bit on your own. Two course (goulash in stew-pot, desserts and drinks will be served in the restaurant of Main square of Szentendre having gypsy music during the lunch). The tour ends in Budapest.

Half Day Empress Sissy Tour



Guided visit the second largest baroque chateau of the world, the former summer residence of Her Royal Majesty Elisabeth of Austria (Sissy). The Grassalkovich mansion built in "Hungarian Baroque" style in the 18th century and got back its former beauty in this decade following the dark period of communism, when the whole palace belonged to the occupying soviet army.

Services: we can see the apartments of royal family in original condition, the 28 hectare park and the wings under reconstruction served for the soviet army until 1989. After a cafe and cake in the confectionery of the Palace we return to Budapest

After an aperitif we serve you a 3-course menu with wine accompanied by a varied folklore show - returning to the downtown you can have a marvellous view on the illuminated city from the Citadel.
